Proceed down St. Claude Ave. Turn right onto Lizardi St. Turn left onto Burgundy.

STOP: (Gibson Family) Mercedes Place 5200 Burgundy St.

Turn left onto Andry St. Turn right onto St. Claude Ave. Proceed down St. Claude, turn left onto Tupelo St.

STOP & DIRGE: (Big 9 SA&PC) House of Dancing Feathers 1317 Tupelo St.

Proceed down Tupelo St. to N. Claiborne, turn left onto N. Claiborne Ave., proceed down N. Claiborne Ave. to Fats Domino Ave. Turn left onto Fats Domino Ave. proceed down Fats Domino Ave. to St. Claude. Ave turn right onto St. Claude Ave. Proceed down St. Claude Ave.
