**STOP: Lady Jetsetter Demetrice Martin L. King Blvd. and Freret St.**

Out Martin L. King Blvd to Simon Bolivar, right on to Simon Bolivar to First St. Left onto First St, to Baronne St. Right onto Baronne St, Right onto Second St.

**STOP: Sportsman Corner (2<sup>nd</sup> and D)**

Out Second St. Left onto Danneel St. left onto Third St. Out Third St. to Baronne St. Right onto Baronne St. Out to Washington Ave.

**STOP: Verret's Bar and Lounge**

Out Washington Ave, (Memorial March Honoring Naomi "Shorty" Gibson Washington & Saratoga) to Freret St. Right onto Ferret St. to Gen. Taylor, Right onto Gen. Taylor.

**STOP: Silky's Bar**

Out Gen. Taylor St. to Claiborne Ave., Right onto Claiborne Ave. to Toledano St. Left onto Toledano St. to S. Rocheblave St.

**Disband: Foxx Bar 3801 Washington Ave.**
