Tonti to MLK make a left turn onto MLK continuing up to S. Claiborne Avenue making a right turn onto S. Claiborne Avenue. then making a left turn onto Jackson Avenue STOP: "King's Fashion" 2811 Jackson Avenue (Single Men). Proceeding up Jackson Avenue making a right turn onto Simon Blvd. heading toward LaSalle Street & Washington Avenue STOP: (Original Lady Buckjumpers). Continuing up Washington Avenue making a left turn onto Dryades Street & 2nd Street STOP: Sportsman Corner 2433 Dryades Street (2018 King & Queen Toast).

Proceeding up Dryades Street making a left turn onto Phillip Street then a quick right turn onto Oretha Castle Haley Blvd. then another right turn onto Jackson Avenue to St. Charles Avenue STOP: (Sisters of Change). Continue up St. Charles Avenue to 3rd Street STOP: (Undefeated Divas) proceed up St. Charles Avenue making a right turn onto Washington Avenue STOP: Verret's Lounge 1738 Washington Avenue (Compassionate Ladies).

Continuing on Washington Avenue then making a left turn onto Barrone Street to Toledano Street STOP: 1824 Toledano Street (Aunt Mary's House) making another right turn onto Dryades Street. DISBAND: Portside Lounge 3000 Dryades Street.
